Common symptoms are, but not limited to; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Program crashes on exit Mouse jerkiness Navigation is choppy 	<p>These issues are predominantly on Mac but are also seen in Windows. The temporary fix is to uninstall the current version of Flash and down grade to 10.0 or lower. A patch for a permanent fix is currently in development.</p> <p>Flash uninstaller</p>
<p>LEGO® MINDSTORMS® Education Flash 10.3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> NXT software has a compatibility issue with Flash 10.3. Common symptoms are, but not limited to; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> No animations in the Lobby or Robo Center 	<p>These issues are predominantly on Mac. The temporary fix is to uninstall the current version of Flash and down grade to 10.0 or lower. A patch for a permanent fix is currently in development.</p> <p>Flash uninstaller</p>
<p>LEGO® MINDSTORMS® Education Windows 7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The software doesn't allow installation on the Windows 7 Starter Edition Platform 	<p>Download Available – Windows 7 Script</p> <p>Follow the steps included with the download link</p>
<p>LEGO® Education WeDo™ – Apple MAC OS Lion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The WeDo installers are not compatible with Lion 	<p>Patch Download Available – click here and search for software downloads</p> <p>Download and unzip the file to your desktop. Read the “read me” text and follow the instructions. This workaround is intended to be run while the LEGO Education WeDo CD is in the disc drive, waiting to be installed.</p>
